### Lumsden to Rowan's Ravine Provincial Park Saturday June 8

**Start: 9:30am** Lumsden Museum, 50 Qu'Appelle Drive W, Lumsden to Rowan's Ravine Provincial Park

- Ride:**
- Lumsden to Craven (8.7 km, highway 641N)
  - Craven to Silton (14 Km, highway SK-20 N and SK 322 N).  
Snack/rest/turnaround @ D's Place, highway 322, opens at 11am.
  - Silton to Rowan's Ravine (32 km, highway SK 322 N) Lunch at Mama Bear's Den.  
*"Licensed little restaurant located in Rowan's Ravine Provincial Park. Mama Bear's Den is Home of the Bannock Burger! We are known for our fresh cut fries, cook to order fresh food and satisfying brunches and amazing fresh Bannock Cinnamon Buns!"*

**Note:** Provincial Park Entry information:

- A valid Park entry permit (\$11/day) is required for all cyclists under 65. Cyclists who turn 65 this year qualify for free entry (**SK Seniors over 65 permits are FREE** with valid Saskatchewan ID). Everyone is to have Photo ID. Please note/visit their website
- "IMPORTANT NOTICE: The Park Entry Gate at Rowan's Ravine Provincial Park is closed. Please purchase your Park Entry Permit online prior to your visit."

- SAG Vehicle will be required to pay \$11 day pass.
- ~1:30pm Return to Silton, (planned stop for ice cream), Craven, Lumsden

### Lumsden to Erdman Farm Sunday June 9

**Start: 9:30am** Lumsden Museum 50 Qu'Appelle Drive W, Lumsden to Erdman Farm with stop at Over the Hill Orchards and Winery on return ride to Lumsden.

**Ride:** Lumsden to Erdman Farm (highway #SK 734 S)  
Return via Over the Hill Orchards and Winery (stop for refreshments) and back to Lumsden.

For insurance purposes all cyclists are required to follow the designated route. At the end of the ride each day cyclists are welcome to explore on their own if desired.

As a safety precaution, please remember to turn on your lights on your bike during the ride, and ride single file where necessary.
